

ABSTRACT

The Teaching Campus Program Class 3 of 2022 is one of the MBKM programs launched by the Directorate of Learning and Student Affairs, Directorate General of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Culture, Research and Technology (Kemendikbud-Ristek) and in collaboration with the Education Fund Management Institute (LPDP), Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Indonesia.
