POSTHUMAN

International Poster Exhibition

The pandemic has changed the pattern of human communication today. Various technologies have connected physical representation with those who are not close to us. Through technology; Call it the internet, humans have gone beyond exploring reason in capturing the body as a whole. The physical embodiment that appears in the body is no longer limited to the mere structure of physical form because all have met between 'artificial beings' through engineering images of digital screens. This image has made us enter the Posthuman era, or what is commonly called PostHuman; it is a concept originating from the fields of science fiction, futurology.

Posthuman is a concept originating from science fiction, futurology, contemporary art, or philosophy that discusses entities born when humans combine themselves with technology that is a human creation. In simple terms, posthuman is a condition in which humans and intelligent technology become increasingly intertwined. PostHuman is a situation of interaction and human life patterns that open information channels with technology so that they can know, feel, describe and summarize human desires. In other words, with PostHuman, humans have given their souls to synergize with technology to translate their hopes for the future. Human optimism to always look to the future with technology can be grown properly. Maintaining the relationship and usefulness of technology with the existence of human needs is the meeting point of technology created by human creation and innovation

In order to foster optimism in the PostHuman era of Visual Communication Design Study Program, Institut Teknologi Telkom Purwokerto held a poster exhibition by inviting and accepting a selection of works from designers/artists from several countries. Pandemi telah merubah pola komunikasi manusia saat ini, beragam teknologi telah menyambungkan keterwakilan fisik dengan mereka yang tidak sedang berada dekat dengan kita, lewat teknologi; sebut saja internet manusia telah melampaui jelajah nalar dalam menangkap raga secara utuh. Perwujudan raga yang tampak dalam tubuh tidak lagi terbatas pada struktur wujud fisik belaka, sebab semua telah telah bertemu antar 'wujud buatan' melalui citraan rekayasa layar-layar digital. Citraan ini telah menjadikan kita memasuki era Pascamanusia atau yang lazim disebut PostHuman; ialah konsep yang berasal dari bidang fiksi ilmiah, futurologi, Pascamanusia (posthuman) adalah suatu konsep yang berasal dari bidang fiksi ilmiah, futurologi, dan seni kontemporer, atau filsafat yang mendiskusikan entitas yang lahir ketika manusia menggabungkan dirinya dengan teknologi yang merupakan ciptaan manusia. Secara sederhana, pascamanusia merupakan suatu kondisi saat manusia dan teknologi cerdas menjadi semakin terjalin.

PostHuman adalah situasi interaksi dan pola hidup manusia yang membuka kanal-kanal informasi dengan teknologi sehingga dapat mengetahui, merasakan, mendeskripsikan dan merangkum keinginan manusia. Dalam kata lain, dengan PostHuman diri manusia telah menyerahkan jiwanya untuk bersinergi dengan teknologi untuk menterjemahkan harapan-harapannya dimasa depan. Optimisme manusia untuk selalu menatap masa depan dengan teknologi dapat ditumbuhkan dengan baik. Menjaga hubungan dan kebermanfaat atas teknologi dengan eksistensi kebutuhan manusia menjadi titik temu dari teknologi hasil kreasi dan inovasi manusia.
